

Nils Larsson

Nils Larsson is an architect and is Executive Director of the International Initiative for a Sustainable Built Environment (iiSBE), an international non-profit organization. During the 1990's he developed and managed a demonstration program for high-performance buildings for the Government of Canada, which resulted in the first public adoption of the integrated design process (IDP). He is principal developer of the SBTool, a system for assessing the sustainability performance of buildings and is active in several private-sector contracts related to sustainable technologies. He represents four international partners (CIB, iiSBE, UNEP and FIDIC) in managing an international series of regional and global conferences on sustainable built environment, and serves on the scientific committees of four of them. Currently, he represents iiSBE in a contract with UNEP-SBCI to support their preparations for COP21 in Paris. Mr. Larsson is a frequently invited keynote speaker at conferences related to sustainable building and he is a Fellow of the Royal Architectural Institute of Canada.
