

Prof. Dr. Derya Oktay

Derya Oktay (BArch, GU; MSc, METU; PGDipUD, Oxford Brookes Univ; PhD, YTU & Oxford Brookes Univ) is currently Dean of the Faculty of Architecture at the Ondokuz Mayıs University, Samsun. Prior to her current position, she was the Director of the MS in Urban Design Programme and a professor at Eastern Mediterranean University, North Cyprus, and the Founding Director of the Urban Research and Development Center. She also served as the President of the Society for International Development (SID) Lefkosa Chapter in Cyprus. She was a Research Scholar at UC Berkeley, Polytechnic University of Milan, University of Michigan and Oxford Brookes University, a team member in various urban/architectural design projects, and jury member in a number of national and international design competitions. Oktay's research, funded by EU, EC, USAID, EMU and TUBITAK, focuses on sustainable urbanism and architecture, cultural-spatial aspects of housing environments, public urban spaces, and quality of urban life and livability beside her main field of expertise urban design. She is the author of more than a hundred journal articles, chapters, conference papers and books in the areas of urban design, sustainable urbanism and architecture, and quality of urban life. Oktay is on the editorial board of various prestigious journals, i.e. Urban Design International, ICE Urban Design and Planning, and Journal of Civil Engineering and Architecture, and on the Advisory Board of the SolarTechnology and Green Building Cluster (GEOSISTmC) and MIMAR.IST Journal. She also spoke in various international and national platforms as an invited speaker.
