

Prof. Dr. Figen Beyhan

Figen Beyhan graduated from Department of Architecture, Karadeniz Technical University (KTU) and she received her master's degree in 1994 and PhD in 2000 from the same department. She was an assistant lecturer in the Faculty of Engineering and Architecture, KTU between 1995 and 2000. Then, continued her academic life as a Senior Lecturer in Department of Interior Architecture in KTU between 2001 and 2002. She was assigned an Assistant Professor of Architecture in same department between 2003 and 2008. She was a visiting scholar at the Faculty of Building Environment, University of New South Wales in Sydney, Australia for 6 months.
