

Assist. Prof. Dr. Onur Dursun

Onur Dursun was awarded Bachelor of Science degree in Civil Engineering from Istanbul Technical University (ITU) in 2006. Shifting his motivation from engineering to project and construction management, he completed two full time Master programs at ITU and University of Reading, respectively. From 2007 to 2009, he was appointed as a research and teaching assistant at project and construction management division, faculty of architecture, ITU. Subsequently, Dr. Dursun gained admission to undertake his Doctorate of Engineering (Dr.-Ing.) research at the Institute for Construction Economics, University of Stuttgart. Between September 2009 and 2014, he was employed as a lecturer and researcher at the same institute. Since September 2014, Dr. Dursun has appointed as Assistant Professor at Architecture Faculty, Yasar University, Izmir, Turkey. His teaching activities involve in wide range of topics related to construction management such as procurement, contract administration, building lifecycle management, and economic evaluation. His research, on the other hand, focuses on stochastic parametric modeling at the preplanning stages of building projects, building surrogate modelling in energy consumption and daylighting, and multi objective evolutionary algorithms applied in architectural design.
